

Entry requirements for University of Southern Denmark (SDU)

In connection with your participation at The Minority Changemaker Programme at Jaruplund Højskole you have the opportunity to apply for admission to the University of Southern Denmark in order to gain ECTS credits for the academic lectures you will get in the course **Minorities, nationalism and political conflicts**.

You can apply for admission on bachelor's level.
The bachelor is offered at the BSc in European Studies.

Entry requirements for [BSc in European Studies](#)

To be eligible for admission, you must hold a qualifying upper secondary school degree, and you must have passed the following courses:

- English level B
- Mathematics level B
- History level B or Social Sciences level B or History of Ideas level B or Contemporary History level B

English must be passed with a grade equivalent to 3.0 or higher in the Danish grading scale (2 is passed, 12 is max). *Course levels refer to the Danish high school system: A is advanced, B is intermediate, and C is beginner level.*

Please see which [documents](#) are required to include to your application; documentation may vary depending on in which country you have taken your education.

How to apply:

Application deadline February 24.

If you **cannot** receive transfer of credits, you apply as a [Single Course](#) student.

If you wish to receive a **transfer of credits** at you home university, you must apply as a [Fee pay guest student](#).

Please make sure you also include documentation of your current studies and a confirmation of credit transfer from your home university.
